<b>Pros of CPD policy</b>	Organisation of CPD events by all 12 AITI's regional divisions, sometimes in cooperation (esp. webinars); central quality-based grading system under coordination of AITI's national CPD Committee
<b>Cons of CPD policy</b>	Most CPD events are organised in spring and autumn only; more specific CPD events for interpreters are required
<b>Same rates as members for FIT associations</b>	YES
<b>Mutual recognition of attendance</b>	YES
<b>Recognition of attendance at CPD events run by non-FIT third parties in the T&amp;I sector where CPD is relevant</b>	YES
<b>Recognition of attendance at CPD events run by third parties not in the T&amp;I sector where CPD is relevant</b>	YES
<b>Interested in collaborating with other FIT associations to deliver CPD events</b>	YES
